Senior National Heavy	(R36.05(b)) 155kg - Max Kart weight 88kg
Senior Clubman Light	(R34.05(a)) 140kg
Senior Clubman Heavy	(R34.05(b)) 160kg - Max Kart weight 88kg
Rotax Light	(R19.37) 160kg

6. Entry

All drivers must hold a Current AKA full competition Race Licence. **For Rotax and Midget classes a Minimum of a B Grade Licence.** Provisional Licences are not acceptable for this series. To be eligible to race in this series you must be registered prior to each event.

Entry Fee is \$125 per class.

ONLY PSC competitors that are registered and have competed in two PSC rounds during 2008 are eligible to enter the final round.

Series Registration Fee is \$55.00 per driver. A discount will apply if two or more dependant siblings or father / son, etc are racing. Dependants must be at school/uni/tech etc. Second and subsequent registration fees shall be \$45.00 each. Only one registration is required per entrant.

Payment for the presentation dinner must be made with your race entry. Cost for the dinner is \$49 for each adult and \$25 for each child under the age of 10.

9. Format of Racing

Grid positions for the heats will be based upon the current standings in the Premier State Cup. The competitor with the highest points in a class will be off grid position 1 for the heats, the 2nd highest off grid position two and so forth down the grid.

There will be NO PRACTICE Monday to Friday inclusive of the week leading up to each round. Penalty for breaching practice limitations will be automatic exclusion from the event. This limitation includes the use of karts intended for competition in the Premier State Cup event driven by non PSC entrants.

10. Abandonment or Postponement

The organisers reserve the right at their sole discretion to abandon, postpone or cancel any event(s) subject to Rule 11.09.

12. Mechanical Breakdown Lane

A mechanical breakdown lane will be in use Rule 17.10

13. Blue and Red Double Diagonal Flag

The blue and red double diagonal flag will be used during this meeting.
Rule 15.13.

14. Round Prizes

Prizes will be offered at each round of the series. These prizes will be drawn 'out of the hat' at the trophy presentations at each round. Competitors must attend presentations to be eligible for prizes. If a competitor is not in attendance when their name is called the prize will be redrawn.

15. Footwear

Covered footwear MUST be worn in the paddock/parc ferme, Ingrid and out grid

16. Pit crew Passes

All pit crew entering restricted areas (the outgrid, The Ingrid, parc ferme and track) Must hold and wear a current Pit crew pass per rule 11.06 entry will be denied if correct pass is not produced

17. Parc ferme/Paddock

Rules 17.11 applies

18. Insurance

Insurance has been affected for this meeting as per Chapter 3

19. Fuel (as per Chapter 22)

The control fuel for this meeting is Caltex Vortex 98 premium unleaded. Fuel testing will be conducted and anyone found to be not using the control fuel will be penalised.
